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FOREWORD FROM OUR CHAIR // connecting the dots

It is my honour and extreme privilege, as Chair of the Advisory Board, to write this introduction to our 2nd annual Connect by Nova Impact report, covering our operations for 2021/22. In January 2022, Connect by Nova's question was, 'How can we do more?' We are proud to say we made substantial strides in supporting the Cayman community in 2022, and we hope this report is a testament to this.

As the world was still struggling to come to terms with the impact of COVID-19 and try to get back to some sense of normalcy, Connect by Nova was able to continue to be a valuable resource for the Cayman community and worked hard to promote our developmental programs.

2022 saw some real growth and expansion with Connect by Nova; we sought feedback from the community, 95% of whom wanted our programs and services integrated into the schools. This produced one of our defined goals for 2021/2022 and honed our focus on integration within educational institutions. With our plan,

'**Unlocking Cayman's Future: Endless Possibilities**', we secured sponsorship from several companies on island, enabling us to further integrate with the educational institutes, bringing new programmes to life and strengthening our relationships within the community. In particular, our partnership with Apex Fund Services allowed us to introduce a 5-week Budgeting and Finance Course.

In 2021/22, we provided 15 workshops within the high schools and universities, providing careers readiness resources to 472 students across our islands, and we're confident that this will grow in 2023.

Despite all these wins, we still see so much need in the community to connect Caymanians to appropriate employment. I am confident that with Connect by Nova, and our continued partnerships with all of you, we can make further progress to bridge the gap between the private, public, and education sectors to help improve the Caymanian unemployed and underemployment problems.





THE EDUCATION LANDSCAPE

Based on surveys and feedback from our partners within the educational institutions, we understand the importance of providing young Caymanians with the knowledge and tools necessary to achieve career success.

To do this, we've partnered with five different educational institutions nationwide, consisting of public high schools and tertiary education, to provide workshops, resources, and support to students transitioning into higher education or the job market.

'CONNECTING OUR FUTURE': HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

The 'Connecting Our Future' programme, in partnership with the Cayman Islands Department of Tourism, will run for the duration of the 2022/23 academic year. This programme aims to prepare high school-aged students in Years 9 through 12 with the necessary soft skills and work readiness training to be well-rounded professionals ready for full-time employment.

After this initiative, thanks to the Cayman Islands Department of Tourism sponsorship, Connect is **projected to reach 700+ students across our islands**, supporting students with information to succeed in the next chapter in their career journey.

SERVICES OFFERED TO STUDENTS

FURTHERING EDUCATION

Connect by Nova has on-the-ground labour market knowledge to help individuals choose a strong course of study that not only meets the talent demand in Cayman but will fit each individual's unique abilities and personality.

Our Careers Team has developed a framework to help students identify and analyse university options that best align with their unique career goals. Once the universities and programs have been decided, we then assist students through the following stages covering everything from personal statements to university applications, including financial aid and interview preparation if necessary

CASE STUDY: Further Education

X, age 17, was referred to work with a Career Consultant to support them with building their personal statement for university applications. The goal for X was to get accepted into a Radiotherapy & Oncology programme. Through weekly sessions, the Career Consultant worked one-on-one with X, building a personal statement highlighting the student's accomplishments and passion for a career in the medical field. In addition to supporting student X with their personal statement, the Career Services Team also reviewed the student's resume for future internship and employment applications

SERVICES OFFERED TO STUDENTS

SCHOLARSHIPS

Connect believes in supporting students throughout their career journey, which begins with identifying further education options and financial aid to achieve these goals. When a student works one-on-one with our Careers team, we identify university options, scholarships available, and the steps required to apply.

Our Careers Team works in partnership with our corporate sponsors and other private and public sector organisations to maintain an up-to-date directory of apprenticeships, internships, and graduate/entry-level positions available on-island that may be suitable for students and recent graduates.

WHO WE WORK WITH // career support for adults

Connect offers career guidance for adults via various tailored support services, including job-seeking advice, redundancy support, and advice for those pursuing a career change.

1. JOB SEEKING

For individuals requesting assistance with their job-seeking goals, Connect can assist through various services, depending on the bespoke needs of each individual. Some of these one-on-one services may include any combination of resume writing, interview prep, network introductions or direct application support and tracking.

As Connect works closely with its founding sponsors, Nova Recruitment and CML Recruitment, the Connect team can share current insights direct from hiring teams across Cayman. This insight is significant for job seekers, as it provides knowledge on what employers are looking for, in-demand professions, desired qualifications and experience required, and the responsibilities of each position. This information is invaluable in enabling job seekers to make more informed decisions towards gainful employment.

2. REDUNDANCY & DISPLACED WORKERS

We still see the effects of displaced workers due to the pandemic; these displaced individuals have a unique opportunity to re-visit their career choices when facing redundancy. Our Careers Team works one-on-one to advise, develop, and explore viable career and education options, encouraging displaced and recently-made redundant Caymanians to re-enter the workforce.

3. CAREER CHANGE

The prospects of a career change, particularly in an economy faced with uncertainty, can be daunting. Our Careers Team works with individuals seeking a career change to curate tailored career action plans to assist in this process. These career action plans allow individuals to explore new industries and careers that align with their unique goals and the current labour market needs.

CASE STUDY: Job Seeking

Z's goal was to obtain full-time employment at a global firm within the Human Resources industry. Our Career Services team conducted multiple career advancement sessions with Z, primarily focused on adding more detail to their applications and refining their resume. During Z's career advancement sessions, the Career Consultant covered all the career possibilities, such as networking opportunities, joining the local HR society, and speaking to their current employer about options internally to gain more exposure to HR. These steps were then outlined in a detailed career action plan to build the foundation for achieving Z's long-term career goals.

Z began focusing on what could be done immediately at their current workplace while also applying to advertised posts that aligned with their career interests. Z began to receive exposure to human resources at their employer, and with the support of their employer, Z was able to complete their Certificate in Human Resources Management and become a member of the Cayman Islands Society of Human Resources Professionals (CISHRP). Z also received comprehensive interview preparation and guidance before their interviews. Z interviewed for various positions, and with the support from Connect, learned to analyse the feedback from each application/interview to better prepare for the next and make more informed decisions on if a role was a good fit. Z was finally offered a position as a Human Resources Administrator at a global law firm.

ONLINE TRAININGS

The career team at Connect has created a range of bite-size training courses available for free for anyone in the Cayman Islands to attend, with virtual access, meaning those in the Sister Islands can still benefit from these resources.

Specifically, in 2021/22, our attendance rate for workshops and trainings increased by 17%, from 53% in 2020/21 to 70% in 2021/22.

CONNECT 'PARTNER' SERIES



Connect by Nova partnered with APEX Fund Services to provide a free five-part **"Budgeting & Finance" course** for individuals to learn to demystify concepts around managing personal finances, enabling users to examine their relationship with money and better understand their money habits.

Each week, participants left with practical tips that they could immediately apply in their everyday life to feel more empowered with their finances.


